Guidelines for Recording

Option 1 – Zoom (video+audio)

- 1. Install the latest version of Zoom Client on your computer or device from http://zoom.us/download. Once the
 - application has installed, click Sign In (for existing account users) or Sign up free to create an account.
- 2. From the Zoom home screen, click **Meetings** in the top navigation menu.
- 3. In your Personal Meeting window, click Start.





4. With the Zoom meeting window open, hover your mouse over the bottom of the window. You should see the menu bar below.

- 5. Join Audio by either using a microphone or headset through your computer; or if you are using your laptop, you can use your built-in computer audio.
- 6. Click the Start Video button to capture yourself on video while speaking.
- 7. If you would like, you may use the ISPNO 2020 Zoom Virtual Background available for download on our website.
- 8. Click the **Record** button to start your audio and video recording.
- 9. You can pause or stop your recording at any point during the presentation. Clicking End Meeting will stop the recording as well.
- 10. Either before or after you start your recording, click Share Screen to select and start sharing the screen with your presentation file. Once you start sharing your screen, the menu will move to the top of your screen. To start your recording after sharing your screen, click More and select Record.





11. After your recording is complete, go to **Meetings (1)** at the top of the Zoom window. To see your recordings, click on the tab labeled **Recorded (2)**. After you select the presentation you want to view, click **Open (3)**. This will open the folder where the recording is saved. By default, the recordings are saved in your **Documents** folder in a sub-folder called Zoom.
